- Before reaching to any analysis or conclusion, we should not forget that the present urvev is the sample survey of the minority girls who are already going to the schools.
- The survey is based on the analysis of the following fifteen variables
- 1 Occupational status of Father/ Guardian of the minority girl child.
- Whether the House of the minority girl child is Kachcha or Pucca.
- 3 Whether the House of the minority girl child is own/rented?
- 4 Whether the Electricity connection is available with the minority girl child's house?
- 5 Whether the Drinking Water connection is available with the minority girl child's house?
- Whether the Toilet is available, in house or public toilet with the minority girl child's house?
- 7 Duration of stay in Delhi by the minority girl child

i. Less than 3 years

ii 3-5 Years

iii 6 years & above

- 8 Whether the minority girl child is having any disease / Physical disability?
- Whether the minority girl child is availing any Govt. scheme e.g. Ladli or any other 7scholarship
- 10 General/specific problem being faced by the minority girl child
- 11 Future Vision of the minority girl child
- 12 Expected/desired financial / social Assistance of the minority girl child
- 13 Language vise survey form which was replied / filled in by the minority girl child
- 14 Class vise status of the minority girl child, who has replied to/ filled in the Survey questionnaire.
- 15 The no. of the minority girl child who has replied to the Survey questionnaire that they have contact nos.

Having gone through the above variables, it is concluded that

1. The guardian/ parent of the majority of the minority girl child belong to low income group. Majority of them works as private labour. Even in some cases the family is women headed family. Barring a few cases, majority of the parents/ guardian work in local community. This clearly represents the economic weakness on the part of the parent/ guardian of the minority girl child. The Govt. should consider preparing such financial assistance schemes, as may help the minority girl child to overcome, their economic weakness of their parents, which might come as a hindrance in the growth of the minority girl child.

means by which the different welfare schemes or plan could reached to the minority girl child.

- 8. It is again satisfying to note that 95% of the minority girl child is disease free.
- 9. It is really horrible to note that almost 50% of the minority girl child is not availing any Govt. scheme. This requires immediate attention and the Govt. should consider the ways or means through which the various govt. schemes could be brought to the door steps of the of the minority girl child. It is the need of the hour to organize camps and awareness generation programmes in the localities of the minority girl child to make them aware about the various welfare schemes being offered by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi as well as Govt. of India.
- 10. It is again satisfying to note that almost 76% of the minority girl child have no general/specific problem being faced by them.
- 11. It is very good to note that 1120 out of 2492 minority girl child want to became teacher, 705 have opted to became Doctor, around 10% have opted to be bureaucrats.
- 12. It is very good to note that 784 out of 2492 minority girl child want social and financial assistance both, from the Govt. for their socio-economic empowerment.

280 out of 2492 want financial assistance for Computer education as part of desired financial/social assistance.

Majority of them have opted for financial assistance for higher education.

Some of them have shown concern about the poor infrastructure available in their Schools.

Some of them have desired that the Govt. should take steps to lower the rate of gender discrimination between male and female.

Some of them have desired that the Govt. should take steps to lower the corruption Some of them have desired the govt. to take steps to lower the crime.

- 13. The Survey shows that majority of the minority girl child have responded the questionnaire printed in English/Hindi.
- 14. Majority of the minority girl child who have replied to the questionnaire are either from primary middle or secondary classes.
- 15. It is really good to note that 98% of minority girl child have their contact no. available.

 This is a sign of development in Delhi.
